# GA-1 Acoustic, Rechargeable Mini Headphone Amp



# **Quick Start**

Operation:

- Plug the 6.35 mm jack plug directly into the socket on your guitar.
- Plug a pair of headphones into the "Phones" port.
- Switch the slider on the GA-1 from STANDBY to ON or FX (LED lights up) and start playing. Adjust the volume using the volume controls on the device and on your guitar.
- You can connect an external audio source via AUX, e.g. to accompany a background track. Adjust the volume of the external audio signal using the volume control on the playback device.

#### Controls:

- BLEND: controls the mix balance of original signal and acoustic guitar simulation signal
- TONE: tone control for the acoustic guitar simulation signal
- VOLUME: controls output volume
- **STANDBY / ON / FX** switch: Standby = device off (no signal) / ON = device on warm sound (LED illuminated) / FX = device on bright sound (LED illuminated)

## Charging:

- The GA-1 must be charged when the sound quality deteriorates or the LED goes out.
- Switch off the device and connect it to a mobile phone charger or the USB socket of a computer using the USB cable supplied. The LED lights up during charging. The device is fully charged, when the LED goes out.
- Fully charge the device before not using it for an extended period of time.

- Input: 6,35 mm (1/4") mono jack plugs direct into the guitar
- Phones: 3,5 mm stereo jack connection for headphones, mixer or active speakers
- USB: USB Mini-B port for charging cable
- Aux: 3,5 mm stereo jack connection for external audio source (e.g. phone, tablet, PC ...) *Power supply:* 
  - Rechargeable battery 170 mAh
  - Battery life: ~ 4.5 hours

- USB power adapter 5 V / min. 500 mA (e.g. phone charger) not included
- USB-A to USB-Mini-B charging cable included
- charging current: ~ 210 mA
- charging time: ~ 1,5 h
