# ULTRAWAVE

### **Quick Start Reference Card**

#### **POWER**

Power your Ultrawave with the included power supply. If you are using pedalboard power, be sure to use a regulated 9 Volt DC output that can source at least 150mA.

#### **MAIN CONTROLS**

DRIVE – Adjusts the master Drive control for the multiband distortion.

LEVEL - Adjusts the master Level control.

SUSTAIN – Adjusts the input gain for the pre-distortion compressor.

TREBLE – Cuts or boosts the high frequencies.



- Top Level Presets (Green LED) - #1, #2, #3

## ALT CONTROLS – HOLD DOWN THE CONTROL BUTTON WHILE TURNING KNOB/TOGGLE

(or press control button once to make ALT mode active. LED blinks while ALT mode is active. After 5 seconds, the Ultrawave reverts to normal control mode)

BASS – Cuts or boosts low frequencies using a shelving filter.

#### **NEURO DESKTOP EDITOR – CONNECT VIA USB**

Browse and download factory and community presets from the Neuro library. Design and experiment with your own sounds with the intuitive Ultrawave editing interface.

#### **NEURO MOBILE APP – NOW WITH USB-MIDI CONNECTIVITY**

Use the supplied USB cable with your iOS or Android device's Lightning or USB-C port for new two-way connectivity with the Neuro Mobile App.

#### **NEURO MOBILE APP – CONNECT VIA PHONE**

Use the supplied audio cable from your iOS or Android device headphone jack to INPUT 2 on the pedal to access the Neuro world of presets and controls on-the-go.

Use the Neuro Desktop editor to access and manage hardware presets, customize your hardware options, and browse Neuro Community presets.

#### Neuro Mobile App - Now with Direct MIDI-USB Support

Comprehensive editing for your Ultrawave on the go! The Ultrawave features two-way communication with the Neuro Mobile app using MIDI over USB. To connect the Ultrawave to your mobile device by USB you will need the proper cable adapters.

- iOS Devices Any iOS device with a lightning connector is supported. A "Lightning to USB Camera Adapter" is required. Connect the adapter to the USB A/B-mini cable that was included with your Ultrawave.
- Android Devices Android devices may have either USB-micro or USB-C connectors that will support MIDI over USB communication with the Ultrawave. You will need the appropriate USB B/C (male) to USB A (female) adapter to use with the included USB A/B-mini cable. Note that the USB B-micro to USB A adapter is sometimes called an OTG (On-The-Go) adapter.

Neuro Mobile App one-way communication is also supported on the Ultrawave. Use your device's headphone jack and included TRS cable to connect to Input 2 on your Ultrawave.
