

GENEVA AMP SIM V2

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Volume - Controls the output volume. **Gain** - Controls the amount of gain in the circuit, just like an AC style amp.

Top Boost - Instead of a different channel, dial in a blend between normal and the revered Top Boost channel.

Treble - A straightforward treble control: To the right

boosts treble; to the left cuts. **Bass** - A straightforward bass control: To the right

boosts bass; to the left cuts.

Cab Sim - If using as a DI, flip the switch to the left

Cab sim - it using as a Di, life the switch to the left to engage the speaker simulation.

Pro Thru - Bygasses the Geneva's circuit on the

Dry Thru - Bypasses the Geneva's circuit on the 1/4" output.

The switch on the side? - This is a ground lift

switch. If you have a hum from a ground loop, flip the switch up/away from you.

POWER REQUIREMENTS

9V Center Negative - Using anything else will ruin your pedal and void the warranty. Consumes 12mA.

WARRANTY

All Westminster Effects carry a limited lifetime warranty for pedals sold within the United States and a one-year warranty for pedals sold internationally, for workmanship and components. Thewarranty does not cover misuse or damage due to accidents. Tampering with components such as trimpots voids the warranty.
